2,006 registered voters
by The Harris Poll.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.






US Economy: Right Track / Wrong Track



How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?













Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?




What would you say are the most important issues facing the country today? Please select three.



BIDEN IS NET FAVORABLE IN EYES OF VOTERS; VOTERS ARE SPLIT ON KAMALA HARRIS













Do you think the editors at Facebook are trying to impose their ideology on people or are they neutral in their approach to censoring posts?













Do you think the number of monthly border crossings by illegal immigrants has increased, decreased, or stayed the same since President Biden took office?













Is the Biden administration creating an open border or is it just trying to enforce immigration laws more humanely?




Do you think the Biden border policies are increasing the flow or drugs and crime to the United States or are those policies simply treating people more humanely?






Do you think that people who cross the border with Mexico illegally should be turned back to Mexico or released into the US with a court date?



Do you think vice president Kamala Harris has done a good job, adequate job, or a bad job tackling the root causes of illegal immigration?




Did vice president Kamala Harris make meaningful progress, some progress, or no progress in tackling the root causes of illegal immigration in her recent Central American trip?










Do you consider Russia/China to be an ally or adversary of the United States?




VOTERS VIEW BOTH TRUMP AND BIDEN AS BEING LENIENT RATHER THAN TOUGH ON RUSSIA

Do you think president Trump was too easy, too hard, or about right in his handling of Russia in the last four years?













A MAJORITY OF VOTERS OPPOSE TEACHING STRUCTURAL RACISM IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS





Do you think that the virus originated from an animal market naturally or escaped from a laboratory in China?




Do you think that Anthony Fauci and the National Institute of Health funded gain of function research that takes naturally occurring viruses and makes them more powerful or did they not fund such research?





Is the coronavirus vaccine being rolled out faster than you expected, slower than you expected, or at about the speed you expected?


How would you rate the vaccine roll out so far?














Do you think new cases of the virus are growing, declining, or staying the same?




MOST AMERICANS THINK THE ECONOMY IS RECOVERING FROM COVID; SPLIT ON MANDATORY VACCINATION

Do you think the economy is recovering from the pandemic or still contracting from the pandemic?




Would you favor or oppose a law that required people to be vaccinated?
